Excavations: Nettleton

Arrangements were made, with Mr L. Webb's approval, to excavate an area in the meadowland alongside the Broadmead Brook in May 1972. For this excavation it was essential to employ a mechanical excavator, because of the amount of alluvium in the meadow, which sealed in the deposits below. It was unfortunate that the arrangements made with Mr Wilcox for the use of a bulldozer failed to materialize. We hope, however, to undertake this work, subject to Mr Webb's approval, in the Spring of 1973.
