We continue to look at the medieval landscape of Stony Littleton, to include a medieval farm, mill and pillow mounds for rabbits. This follows on from last year's excursion to the lost village of Foxcote.

Chris Paul is a member of BACAS and founder member and archivist of the Shoscombe History Society, who lives in Stony Littleton, will lead this excursion beginning at Brook Cottage in Stony Littleton.

- The walk will start at 2:00pm
- Distance in total will be approx 2 miles
- Stout footwear is required together with suitable weatherproof clothing.
- The walk is moderate over footpaths and has a height gain of 50m.
- Stony Littleton used to have a pub but it went in 1795. However tea/coffee and biscuits will be provided after the walk.
- Directions: Parking at the 2 red P places indicated and meet at Brook Cottage in Stony Littleton (See map below, Satnav BA2 8NP)
